In our study of the American Revolution, we have been learning about some of the leaders that influenced the events at that time. Each student researched an American Revolutionary leader and then assumed the identity of that leader in a personal narrative. The students then dressed in character and were recorded as they read their narratives.

Follow the directions below, so you can access these videos. You will need a mobile device with a built in camera.

1. Download the [Aurasma](#) app (free).
2. Using your mobile device, connect to our class channel here: <http://auras.ma/s/xSX0e> or scan the QR code below.



3. Hold your mobile device over the image.

Tips

To capture the trigger, click on the dashed-square at the bottom of your screen.



Hold your device about 12 inches away from the target image.
